Commonly Asked Questions About Scholarships

- ❖ Do I have to pay for scholarships?
 - a. No. Scholarships are free money.
- ❖ Is there a limit to the amount of scholarship money I can get?
 - a. No. There is no limit to the amount of scholarship money you can apply for or receive.
- ❖ SCIENCE BOUND gives me a tuition scholarship. Why should I apply for other scholarships as well?
 - a. The tuition scholarship DOES NOT cover housing, meals, books, and other expenses. The more scholarship money you receive, the better!
- ❖ What happens if the amount of scholarship money I receive is more than the cost to attend ISU?
 - a. The extra money may be sent to you as a refund.

**** Beware of Scholarship Scams****

Warning signs of a scholarship scam include the following:

- ❖ Asking for banking information for you or your parents
- ❖ Requiring you to pay for the "scholarship" or pay to submit the "scholarship"
- ❖ Stating you are a "finalist" and you never entered the "competition"
